

The Town of Trinity Council met at a regularly scheduled meeting March 10, 2014 in the Trinity Municipal Building with the meeting being called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Vaughn Goodwin

Motion made to approve the minutes of the previous meeting February 24, 2014 by Chris with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Richard. All voted yes.

Motion made to approve the minutes of the previous work session February 24, 2014 by Chris with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Richard. All voted yes.

Motion made to pay the attached bills in the amount of \$15,215.48 by Chris with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Scott. All voted yes.

Motion made to approve paying John Carpenter Ford \$590.00 to replace front brake rotors and rear pads for 2010 Crown Vic of 403 by Chris with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Richard. All voted yes.

Motion made to approve up to \$15,000.00 for AVL's for the police cars by Richard with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Scott. All voted yes. The mayor stated that the Police Chief will be the only one allowed to turn on or off any officers AVL's and consult with the Mayor on the reason for the switching on or off.

Motion made to refund up to \$415.00 for the purchase of a business license to Pankon Patel when business was not purchase by Scott with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Gordon. All voted yes.



Council discussed purchasing a 6" meter to place at Decatur Recycling. Council discussed other surrounding areas increasing their sales tax rate.

Under old business the council got an update on the agreement with Morgan County Sheriff the Chief has sent a letter asking for parts of the agreement that was missing. The ball fields are still wet and need some dry weather to work the fields. Bill Pettey was unable to speak with Carl Goss on the church property. Bill stated they have not heard anything on the ISO Audit yet. On the 2009 Dodge car police equipment has been removed, will be placing some new tires, car seat covers are ordered and will have the stripes and emblem removed from the car.
