

**RESOLUTION 2016-19  
APPOINTING ELECTION OFFICERS**

**WHEREAS, a municipal option election as to whether to change the status of the Town of Trinity, Alabama from "Dry to Wet" and allow the legal sale and distribution of alcoholic beverages within the Town of Trinity, Alabama pursuant to Title 28 and particularly Section 28-2A-1, Code of Alabama, (1975) has been called to be held on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of August, 2016, and**


**WHEREAS, Section 11-46-27 of the Alabama Code of 1975, and regulations adopted pursuant thereto provide, in part, that the municipal governing body, not less than 15 days before the holding of any municipal election, appoint from the municipality, officers to hold the election as follows: where electronic ballot counters are used at least one inspector and three clerks,**

**WHEREAS, the rate of pay shall be \$25.00 for attending the required Election School to be held at the Hartselle Civic Center August 16, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. The rate of pay on Election Day, August 23, 2016 shall be \$125.00 for the Inspector, and \$100.00 for the Chief Clerk and Assistant Clerks.**
