


**RESOLUTION 2020-27**  
**RESOLUTION TO ADOPT REBUILD ALABAMA**  
**TRANSPORTATION PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, During the 2019 Special Session, in an effort to address infrastructure funding, the Legislature passed House Bill 2 which increased the motor fuel tax by 6 cents in 2019, 2 additional cents in 2020, and 2 additional cents in 2021. HB2 also included the ATRIP-II program setting aside a state match program for local projects of public use; and

**WHEREAS**, for 2019, \$30 million will be available for local governments to apply for. Expected funds and the accountability requirements imposed by the Act enforces requirements on the County and Municipalities as it relates to the expenditure of the funds created.

**THEREFORE, RESOLVED** that the Town of Trinity, Alabama hereby adopt an annual Rebuild Alabama Transportation Plan in acceptance of ATRIP-II Rebuild Alabama Infrastructure Program.
